# Things to Remember: End of Life



Discuss the resident's wishes regarding end of life care.





## **Communication is Key!**

- Review advance directive and Advance Care Plans with the resident and/or legal representative
- Discuss risk/benefit if resident/family requests hospital transfer and document



#### **Increase in Illness and Symptoms**

- Residents may require emergency transfers
- Family visitation may be requested at end-of-life
- Follow pandemic infection control policies for end-of-life visits
- Visits should be in private room if possible



# **Preparing for Visitors**

- Entrance doors should be monitored/secured
- Visitors to schedule time of arrival
- Visitors screened in lobby area per facility policy
- Visitors wash hands and don appropriate PPE



### **Death Rates Will Increase**

- · Mortuaries may be unable to remove the remains of a deceased resident timely
- Create a plan with local hospitals and mortuaries to assist during the pandemic
