





Admitting a Resident with COVID-19



Prepare a **private room**
(if available)

- Away from main resident care
- No extra supplies in the room
- Keep garbage and soiled linen containers inside the room

RN/LPN should be **dedicated** to COVID-19 rooms

- Consider adding a designated nursing assistant as a second team member for 2-person care
- Ensure staff are reviewing all policies necessary, and in-service education is current for all isolation and COVID-19 policies and procedures

Ensure adequate **PPE supplies** are stocked on cart **outside** room with appropriate signage and training to other staff that resident is in Droplet/Contact isolation

In-service staff on the importance of **cluster care** in order to reduce the amount of PPE used during each shift.

Provide staff assigned a **single point of contact** to call should there be any questions related to treatment of a COVID-19 resident

Ensure staff are provided with appropriate training and supplies to enable them to do their job **efficiently** and **effectively** while preventing the risk of spreading infection

Following these steps has **proven** to drastically reduce stress levels and the spread of infection with team members
