
Clean Hands Count contaminating your hands

Use these steps to avoid after you clean them.





Close lid and store container before rubbing hands together.



Rub for approximately 20 seconds, coating all surfaces of both hands, until hands feel dry.



Go directly to patient or resident without putting hands back into pockets or touching anything else.



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Hold container in one hand and dispense enough gel or foam to cover both hands into the other hand.



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

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


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
