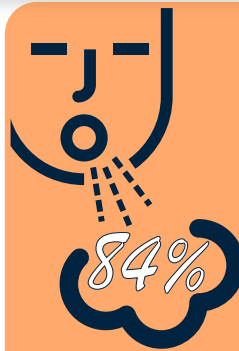

OF COVID POSITIVE PATIENTS EXPERIENCED A FEVER, COUGH, AND SHORTNESS OF BREATH

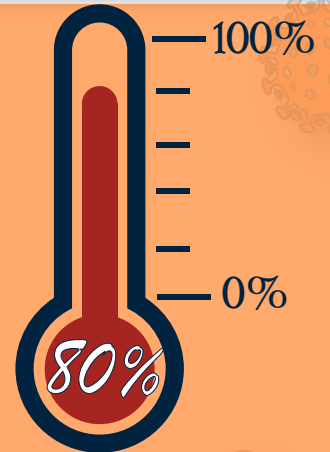

REPORTED THE MOST COMMON SYMPTOM WAS A COUGH



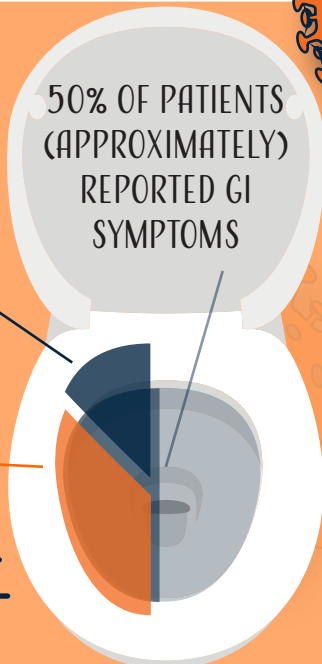
REPORTED HAVING A FEVER, MAKING IT THE SECOND MOST COMMON SYMPTOM
