What you need to know

The intention of the influenza vaccine is to reduce the overall burden of respiratory illness to protect vulnerable populations at risk for severe illness.



I've heard that vaccines can cause Alzheimer's Disease. Autism or the flu itself! Plus. I've had unsuccessful results with vaccines in the past, so I feel like they don't work.

Don't worry! Vaccines do carry the same bacteria or virus that causes the disease. however, they have either been broken down so only a portion of the disease is involved, or killed/weakened so you won't get ill.



Also, the vaccine is intended to introduce the virus to your system, so if you do come in contact with that virus, your body has already developed immunity to it; posing less chances of becoming ill.

If residents or staff are resistant to taking the vaccine, encourage them to discuss with your medical director or their primary care physician to assist in the decision-making process.
